



SHAKY SITUATION—Hoover High School was built in 1930 before the state Legislature passed the earthquake law of 1933. The legislation requires replacement or abandonment of all such school buildings

by June 30, 1975. Pre-1933 buildings at Hoover are the auditorium and the three-story structures at bottom, just off El Cajon Boulevard. The city school district has proposed sale of this area. White blocked
