Dear Dr. Grier:

I am writing in regards to the proposed Hoover High School Stadium Improvement Project. This proposal has been the topic of significant community dialogue in recent months and the project has been revised several times to reflect input from the public. The purpose of this letter is to confirm which revisions have been incorporated into the proposal to date.

It is my understanding that the school district has agreed to incorporate the following conditions into the project:

1. A "walk of fame" will direct spectators from the new parking lot on El Cajon Boulevard through the school, so the only entrance will be on the south side of the stadium in the middle of the campus.
2. The ticket booth, concessions stand, and restrooms will be located on the south side of the fields.
3. Lighting will only be installed on the football field. There will be no lighting of the multipurpose fields.
4. Stadium lights will be approximately 90 feet high and be focused directly on the field. Speakers will be faced away from nearby homes.
5. Ornamental fencing and landscaping will surround the field and will reflect the neighborhood's character.
6. There will be a maximum of 15 events held in the football stadium per year, and the facility will not be rented out for non-school uses such as adult soccer leagues.
7. Campus security will be increased during stadium events.
8. After completion of the Environmental Impact Report, a school district representative will present its findings to the Kensington-Talmadge Planning Group.
9. Community members will be included in all future Site Master Planning and Design Taskforce meetings.

I would appreciate the school district's confirmation or clarification in writing of any of the above statements.

Please know that I support your efforts and am willing to assist you and your staff to make the educational experience of the students in my Council District second to none.
